

AGBS 110 Articulation Agreement Between SUNY Morrisville And Pavilion Central School District Agriculture Career & Technical Education Program



General Student Agreement

The following agreement has been developed to meet the needs of students who are pursuing educational programs in the secondary schools listed below and are continuing their education at SUNY Morrisville.

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to provide a continuing articulation program that builds on past learning experiences and eliminates the unnecessary duplication of instruction. Specific articulation provisions are listed with each course.

Specific Articulation Provisions

In order to receive credit at SUNY Morrisville for AGBS 110 Introduction to Agricultural Business Management (3 credits), the responsible instructor (or designee) from the Agriculture Career & Technical Education (CTE) program at Pavilion Central School agrees to:

- 1. Provide a letter of recommendation verifying the student's proficiency
- 2. Submit the student's CTE program record and certificate of completion
- 3. Provide SUNY Morrisville with a copy of the curriculum outline for the Agriculture CTE program upon initial agreement and renewal agreements
- 4. To notify SUNY Morrisville in writing of any changes to the Agriculture CTE program curriculum

SUNY Morrisville will grant credit whenever the student officially matriculates into one of the following degree programs:

- 1. Agricultural Business, A.A.S.
- 2. Agricultural Business Development, B.B.A.

and meets the following criteria:

1. Students must have a cumulative grade point average of 80 or better in the Agriculture CTE program at Pavilion Central School

Credit will be granted after the first semester of matriculation as long as the student has earned a minimum of 12 credits with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. Upon acceptance to SUNY Morrisville, the student should contact his or her high school counseling department to facilitate the granting of credit.

This agreement will be reviewed and renewed every five (5) years. This agreement will be in effect upon signing by both parties and may be revised upon mutual agreement of both parties.
