## **General Student Agreement**

The following agreement has been developed to meet the needs of students who are pursuing an educational program at <u>Eastern Suffolk BOCES</u> and intend to continue their education at SUNY Morrisville.

The purpose of this articulation agreement is to provide a continuing articulation program that builds on past learning experiences and eliminates the unnecessary duplication of instruction.

## **Specific Articulation Provisions**

Students who have successfully completed either the <u>Auto Body Repair & Car Customizing or Automotive Technology</u> program at <u>Eastern Suffolk BOCES</u>, have participated in a work based learning activity, and have earned a Career Technical Education endorsement between June 2020 and June 2022 will be eligible to earn three (3) credits at SUNY Morrisville for AUTO 110: Summer Work Experience and one (1) credit for AUTO 138: Career Awareness.

In order to receive these credits, the student must provide a copy of his/her BOCES Certificate of Completion which includes the Career Technical Education endorsement, along with a CTE instructor recommendation letter, by the end of the first week of their first semester at SUNY Morrisville. Credit will be awarded upon successful completion of one year of full-time coursework at SUNY Morrisville. Successful completion, in this case, is defined as earning a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better.
