CITA 110 CITA 120 Articulation Agreement Between SUNY Morrisville And Broome-Tioga BOCES

General Student Agreement

The following agreement has been developed to meet the needs of students who are pursuing educational programs in the secondary schools listed below and are continuing their education at SUNY Morrisville.

The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to provide a continuing articulation program that builds on past learning experiences and eliminates the unnecessary duplication of instruction. Specific articulation provisions are listed with each course.

Specific Articulation Provisions

In order to receive credit at SUNY Morrisville for CITA 110 Introduction to Information Technology (3 credits) and CITA 120 Computer Concepts and Operating Systems (3 credits), the responsible instructor (or designee) from Broome-Tioga BOCES agrees to:

1. Provide a letter of recommendation verifying the student's proficiency

- 2. Submit the student's CTE program record and certificate of completion
- 3. Provide SUNY Morrisville with a copy of the curriculum outline for the IT Specialist program upon initial agreement and renewal agreements
- 4. To notify SUNY Morrisville in writing of any changes to the IT Specialist curriculum

SUNY Morrisville will grant credit whenever the student officially matriculates into one of the following degree programs:

- 1. Computer Information Systems, A.A.S. or A.S.
- 2. Information Technology: Application Software Development, B.Tech.
- 3. Information Technology: End-User Support, B.Tech.
- 4. Information Technology: Network Administration, B.Tech.
- 5. Information Technology: Web Development, B.Tech.

and meets the following criteria:

1. Students must receive a cumulative average of 80 or better in the IT Specialist program at Broome-Tioga BOCES

Upon acceptance to SUNY Morrisville, the student should contact his or her high school and/or BOCES counseling department to facilitate the granting of credit. Credit for CITA 110 and CITA 120 will be granted upon full-time matriculation at SUNY Morrisville, usually within 3 weeks after the start of a student's first semester.

This agreement will be reviewed and renewed every five (5) years. This agreement will be in effect upon signing by both parties and may be revised upon mutual agreement of both parties.
