FSAD 100 TOUR 106 Articulation Agreement Between SUNY Morrisville And Broome-Tioga BOCES

General Student Agreement

The following agreement has been developed to meet the needs of students who are pursuing educational programs in the secondary schools listed below and are continuing their education at SUNY Morrisville.

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The purpose of this Articulation Agreement is to provide a continuing articulation program that builds on past learning experiences and eliminates the unnecessary duplication of instruction. Specific articulation provisions are listed with each course.

Specific Articulation Provisions

In order to receive credit at SUNY Morrisville for FSAD 100 Global and Ethnic Foods (3 credits) and TOUR 106 Introduction to the Travel-Tourism/Hospitality Industry (3 credits), the responsible instructor (or designee) from Broome-Tioga BOCES agrees to:

- 1. Provide a letter of recommendation verifying the student's proficiency
- 2. Submit the student's CTE Program Student Record
- 3. Provide SUNY Morrisville with a copy of their curriculum outline for the Hospitality Industry Careers program upon initial agreement and renewal agreements
- 4. To notify SUNY Morrisville in writing of any changes to the Hospitality Industry Careers curriculum

SUNY Morrisville will grant credit whenever the student officially matriculates into one of the following degree programs:

- 1. Culinary Arts Management, A.A.S.
- 2. Food Service Administration, A.A.S.
- 3. Gaming and Casino Management, A.A.S.
- 4. Restaurant Management, A.A.S.
- 5. Travel and Tourism: Hospitality Management, A.A.S.
- 6. Resort and Recreation Services Management, B.B.A.

and meets the following criteria:

1. Students must receive a cumulative average of 80 or better in the Hospitality Industry Careers program at Broome-Tioga BOCES

Upon acceptance to SUNY Morrisville, the student should contact his or her high school counseling department to facilitate the granting of credit. Credit for FSAD 100 and TOUR 106 will be granted upon full-time matriculation at SUNY Morrisville, usually within 3 weeks after the start of a student's first semester.

This agreement will be reviewed and renewed every five (5) years. This agreement will be in effect upon signing by both parties and may be revised upon mutual agreement of both parties.
